## ST JAMES HOUSE

The House continues to provide quality support for men & women in recovery from addiction. The property is maintained to a high standard and is registered with Bristol City Council as an HMO.



During the latter part of 2017 we began an upgrading programme for the property:

- New Radiators have been fitted throughout;
- Residents Rooms are being upgraded one at a time. 3 have been completed so far.
- It costs £3,000 to upgrade each room.

The service provides individuals with housing and general support during their time as residents. There is an expectation that they are involved in voluntary work and/or education.

Residents are provided with support for up to 2 years. However, with the shortage of social housing and increased demand for move on accommodation some have been supported for 3 years.
