He also celebrates Mass every Sunday at 8am. This has led to a core group of people who regularly attend during the week. Eucharistic Adoration continues Mon–Fri 10am – 4pm.

ST JAMES HOUSE

The House continues to provide quality support for men & women in recovery from addiction.

The property is maintained to a high standard and was re-registered with Bristol City Council as an HMO in 2019.

The upgrading programme for the property, which started in 2018, has continued as and when we have secured funding:

- Residents Rooms are continuing to be upgraded one at a time.
- It costs £3,000 to upgrade each room.

The service that we offer is an independent provision which our Charity funds. Individuals are given housing and general support during their time as residents. There is an expectation that they are involved in voluntary work and/or further education.

Residents are provided with support for up to 2 years. However, due to the shortage of social housing and the increased demand for move on accommodation we are supporting some for 3 years.
